TO KEEP YOU IN THE BIG PICTURE

An incredible journey: First borrowing operation under the NextGenerationEU brings over €20 billion to finance Europe's recovery. On 15 June the Commission raised €20 billion to finance Europe's recovery from the coronavirus crisis. This is the largest amount the EU has raised in a single transaction. The positive assessment given by the Commission to the recovery and resilience plans of Greece, Spain, Portugal, Denmark and Luxembourg were followed by official visits of the Commission President to hand-deliver the plans. Austria, Slovakia, Latvia, Germany, Italy, Belgium and France were next on the list. Here is more.

In good health: EU starts ambitious funding programme for health, paving the way towards a strong European Health Union. Starting 18 June, <u>EU4Health</u> will fund more modern and resilient health systems, interventions to shore up our preparedness against health crises and more decisive EU action in the fight against cancer. The first annual work programme of EU4Health will provide €312 million for crisis preparedness, disease prevention, health systems and the healthcare workforce, and digitalisation.



No one left behind: New initiatives to ease the plight of refugees see the day. On the occasion of the World Refugee Day on 18 June, the Commission announced a new initiative, the <u>Lives in Dignity Grant Facility</u>, that seeks new forms of collaboration between humanitarian, development and peace actors to address the most challenging situations of forced displacement in the world. Together with the new <u>Talent Partnerships</u>, aiming to better match the skills of workers from outside Europe with the EU labour market, this initiative comes to show that the EU is determined to address the persistent difficulties faced by refugees. Follow here the joint statement by the Commission and the High Representative.
